

# NOTICE OF RACE-August 23-24, 2014

## Hobie Div. 11 Season Points Regatta & Pig Roast

### Spray Beach Yacht Club

#### RULES

The Regatta shall be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing 2013-2016, the prescriptions of US SAILING, and the class rules of the Hobie Class Association.

#### CLASS

Any multi-hull catamaran boat complying with International Hobie Class Association Class Rules.

#### ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

The event is a bring-your-own-boat regatta open to all participants and any catamaran boat complying with International Hobie Class Association.

Any fleets of less than 5 boats may be combined into a single Portsmouth Yardstick raced fleet.

**Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$100,000 per event or the equivalent thereof. Proof of liability insurance must be provided at the time of registration. Proof of insurance can be obtained from your insurer with a separate statement of binding coverage. You must provide a copy at the skippers meeting on August 23, 2014.**

#### ENTRY AND FEES

Entry shall be made by completing the entry form available at [spraybeachyc.org](http://spraybeachyc.org) or on site at SBYC, and paying the entry fee of \$60 for a double handed boat, and \$40 for a single handed boat (payable to Hobie Fleet 267). Under 18 years of age Junior entrance fee for a double handed boat (both sailors Juniors) will be \$10.00 and \$5.00 for single handed boat.

The skipper of each boat shall be charged a \$5.00 surcharge if not a North American Hobie Cat Association ("NAHCA") member, and a separate \$5.00 surcharge if not a US Sailing individual or family member.

**SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:** The sailing Instructions shall be available at registration and may be posted on the SBYC web site at [www.spraybeachyc.org](http://www.spraybeachyc.org).

**MEASUREMENT:** All boats may be inspected throughout the event for class rule compliance.

**SCORING & RACE RESULTS:** The Low-Point Scoring System, Appendix A of the racing rules, shall apply. Race Results will be posted online shortly after the regatta at [www.sbyc.us/results.htm](http://www.sbyc.us/results.htm). and [www.spraybeachyc.org](http://www.spraybeachyc.org)
